This Dressage Schooling Show will run simultaneously with our KHJA JUMPER SHOW. We will have jumper classes from 18" to 3'6 in height. If you wish to complete your dressage test first, and miss your jumping height with the KHJA scheduled show, we will have stadium rounds available at the conclusion of our regular jumper show schedule. We also have a large field with a variety of cross country obstacles.

WARNING: Under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to Sections 1 through 4. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity.
